

## **Frontier Lanes Will Reopen to Public on 5/19/2020**

### **New Sanitization and Social Distancing Protocols in Place to Ensure Safer Environment**

**Stillwater, 5/15/2020 – Frontier Lanes**, which has been providing family fun and entertainment to Stillwater since **1962**, will reopen its doors to the public on **May 19, 2020** after a **2 month** closure that was mandated by the **City of Stillwater and the State of Oklahoma** for all non-essential businesses in an effort to combat the spread of COVID-19.

“The health and well-being of our customers and employees is our top priority,” said **Ernie Simmons**. “Since the **City of Stillwater and State of Oklahoma** announced that certain non-essential businesses would have the opportunity to resume full business operations, we have been conducting a comprehensive review of city, state and federal operating guidelines and how they apply to our center. Based on our review, which we have done in consultation with local health and medical professionals, we will be prepared to welcome back the public on **May 19, 2020.**”

During the time that **Frontier Lanes** has been closed to the public, center management has been focused on new methods of sterilization and deep cleaning of its entire facility located at **3524 N Washington St in Stillwater**. The center has also revamped and updated its operational processes and procedures to best ensure the safety of its guests and employees, including **disinfecting bowling shoes and house balls between each use**. The **16 lane** center, which plans a phased approach to its opening, will initially limit the number of customers occupying its facility at any one time as it adheres to state and municipal required social distancing guidelines that are still in place.

“We have a very large and spacious establishment, which will allow for us to properly place bowlers across our lanes at a safe and comfortable distance apart,” said **Ernie Simmons**. “We want to provide all of our bowlers with a respite during these difficult times but do so in a way that’s carefully planned in order to keep our employees and bowlers safe and healthy.

We will be encouraging reservations, but not requiring them, to help us better deal with the limitations on the number of customers in place at this time. Details about the reservation process can be found on our Facebook page.
